## Accessing Leganto Reading List from MyAberdeen

This guide explains how staff and students can access the Leganto Reading List in a MyAberdeen course area, and how staff can create links to the reading list from within the course content.

### Access Reading List via Books and Tools

Staff and students can access the course's Reading List via Books & Tools in the Details & Actions menu. Students can only access the Reading List once it has been published.




Figure 1 - Reading List accessed via Books & Tools.

### Create a link for students to access the Reading List

Staff can add a link to the Reading List from within the Course Content page.

1. Click on the plus icon and select Tools.
2. Click the small plus icon on the Reading List card to create a link to the Reading List.




Figure 2 - Plus icon to add a link to the Reading List.

3. The Reading List link will be created in the course area. You can make it visible to students and edit the title and description via the ellipses.

## Create links to individual Reading List items and sections

You can also now create links to individual Reading List items and sections.

1. Click on the plus icon and select Tools (see Figure 2).
2. Select **Reading List – Embed an item from the list**.




Figure 4 - Reading List – Embed an item from the list.

3. Tick the box next to the reading list item(s) or section(s) you wish to link to. Click **Select** to confirm.




Figure 5 – Selecting the item or section to link to.

4. The link(s) will be created in the course area.




Figure 6 – Link to an individual Reading List item.
